## We believe a lactation consultant should:

- + Perform a complete anatomical and functional assessment of the breast and nipple
- + Perform a complete anatomical and functional assessment of the baby's tongue, lips, head, neck, body
- + Perform a weighted feed to evaluate milk transfer (data from a scale capable of measuring small volumes)
- + Provide oral exercises to optimize the baby's oral function

Make referrals to appropriate additional providers

- + Educate families on techniques to ensure complete breast drainage and to prevent infection
- + Create a care plan to establish and maintain adequate supply while also providing baby with adequate nutrition
